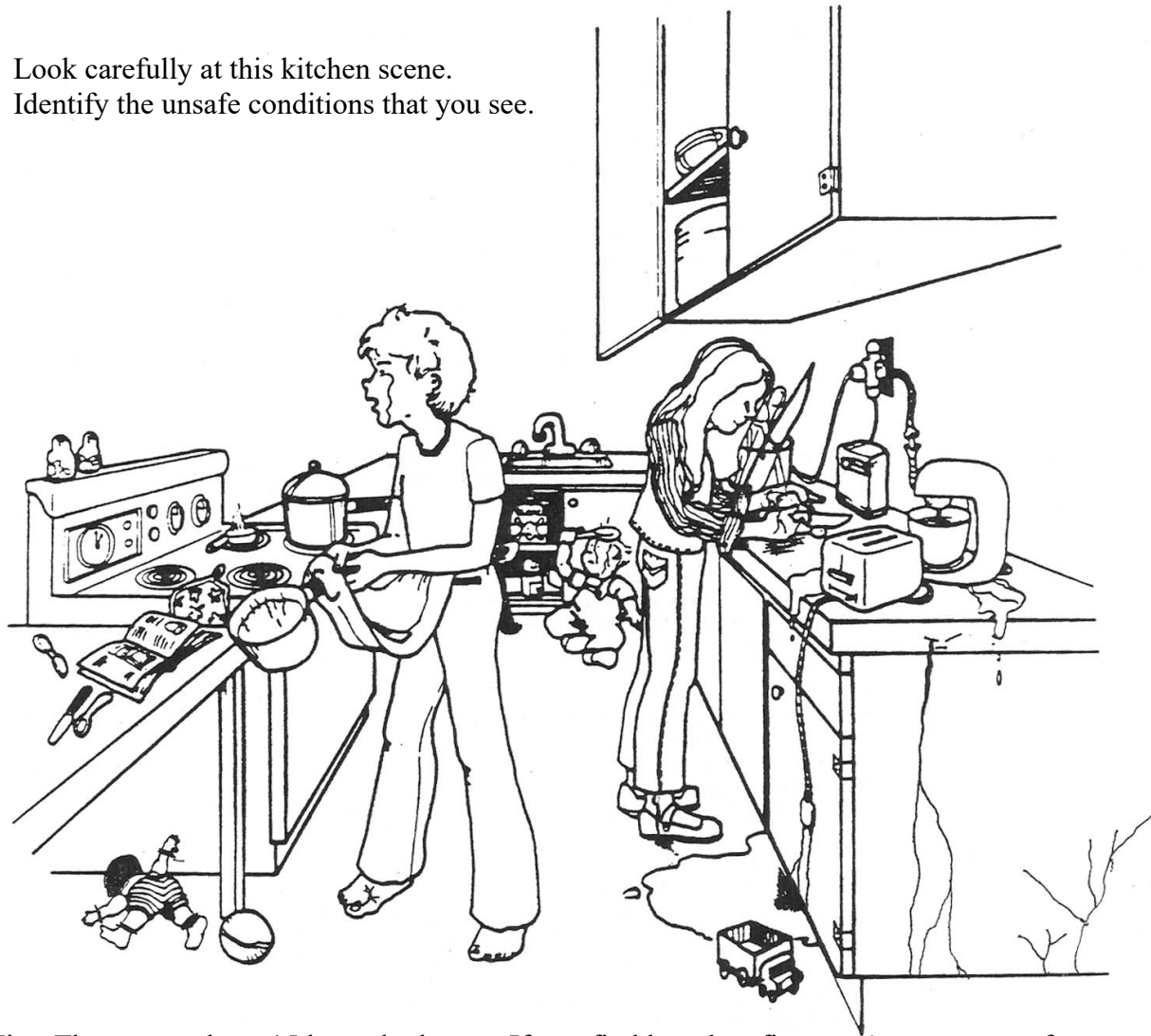


## **Kitchen Safety Exercise**
