- 1. Place the machine as near the electrical outlet as possible.
- 2. Keep the cord out of the way and untangled.
- 3. Always hold the plug when unplugging the machine. Never jerk or pull the cord.
- 4. If the cord becomes worn of or frayed, tell teacher and have it replaced immediately.
- 5. Use machine light for accuracy and safety while sewing.
- 6. Hold fabric with fingers well away from the path of the needle.
- 7. Do not sew over pins.
- 8. Sew at low speed until your ability to control the machine improves.
- 9. Keep all backpacks and bags way from the foot pedal.
- 10. Do not sit on the sewing machine or ironing board.
- 11. Keep pins and small equipment away from the needle area.
- 12. Remember to turn of sewing machine when not in use.
